

## ORGANIZING TILES ON THE RACK

There is no set rule for how to organize your Mah Jongg tiles on your rack. Different players organize their tiles differently.

Note: The suggestions below are for a right-handed player. If you are left-handed you may want to switch the far end tiles on the left and right sides of the rack.

- Put the Jokers and Flowers to the far left of your rack (You should **never** pass a Joker in the Charleston and only discard Jokers or Flowers as a last resort hence why they are placed to the far left.)
- Put the Winds (NEWS) to the far right of the rack.
- Between these organize your tiles by suit (Bam, Cracks, Dots) and put those tiles in order numerically from smallest to largest with each suit's dragon last.

Now look at your card and try to determine one or more Sections your tiles might work in. Then place the tiles that most likely would not help your hand to the far right of the rack. These will be your discards. (If you had any Winds, move them to the left of your discards)
